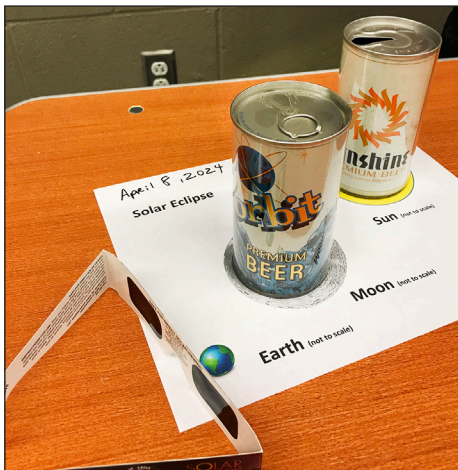


# The Lew Cady *Mile Hi*larious CANtest

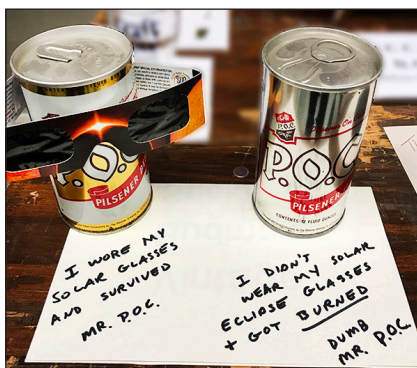

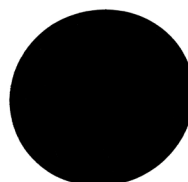

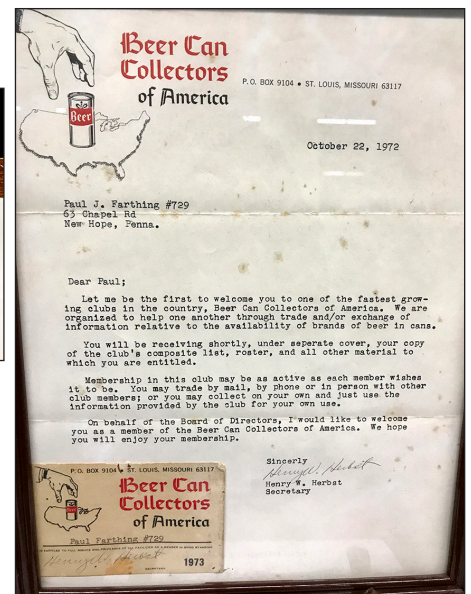

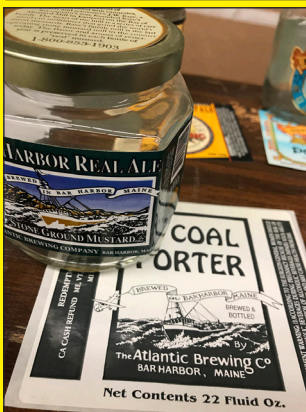
Steve Pawlowski #1168 brought a very impressive collection of "Edible Breweriana" made with beer from various breweries. He paired each with breweriana of the same label.
